PINOT GRIGIO

SPUMANTE BRUT



Grapes:

Pinot Grigio.

Vineyard areas:

The grapes selected for the production of the Canaletto Spumante Pinot Grigio Brut are situated on hillside slopes in the Veneto area at about 200-250 mt. a.s.l. The altitude and winds bring cool nights, which contrast the very hot days granting the perfect conditions for quality white grape growing.

Harvest:

The Pinot Grigio grapes are carefully picked by hand in mid August - relatively early - in order to maintain a high level of acidity and retain the freshness required for a sparkling wine.

Vinification:

The first fermentation takes place at temperature-controlled conditions not exceeding 18 °C for approximately 8-9 days. The secondary fermentation takes place in cuvée close containers and lasts approximately 15 days.

Winemaker's notes:

Straw-yellow in colour, with greenish shades, Canaletto Spumante Pinot Grigio has fine bubbles, with a classic Pinot Grigio pear and green apple notes.

Perfect for any occasion or simply as an aperitif.
